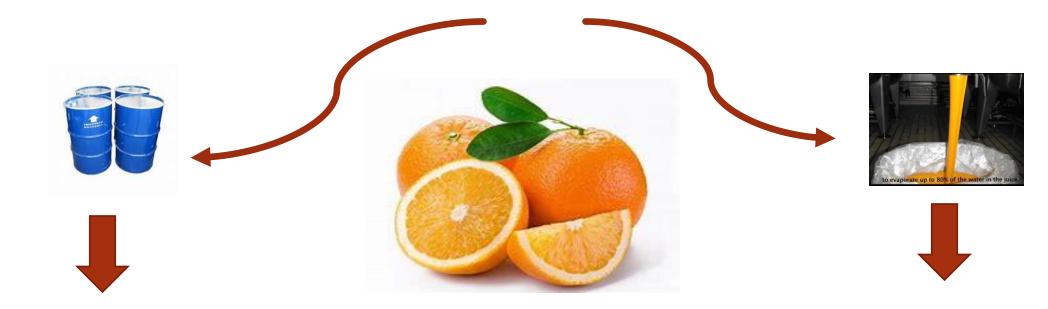

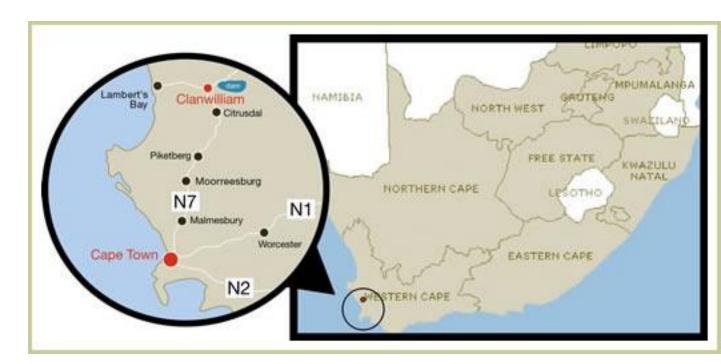
- ► Location Clanwilliam, Cederberg Municipal region (2,5hours north-west of Cape Town)
- ■Cost of project R133m (USD7m) equipment and installation
- ROI 15% net profit after tax
- Raw materials abundant supply is available. We currently manage all low grade fruit in the northern part of the citrus valley
- ■USP Transforming a low grade fruit into a high value commodity through extraction (not juicing)

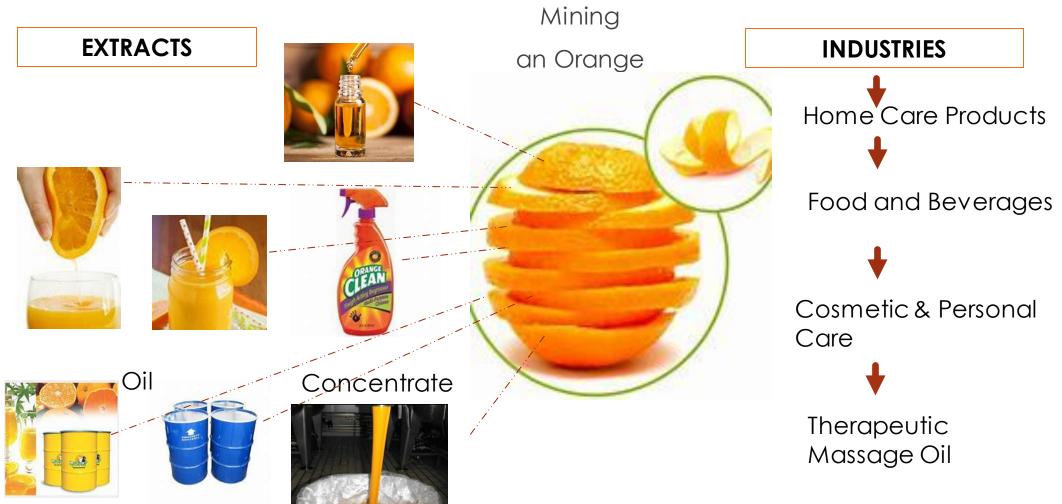

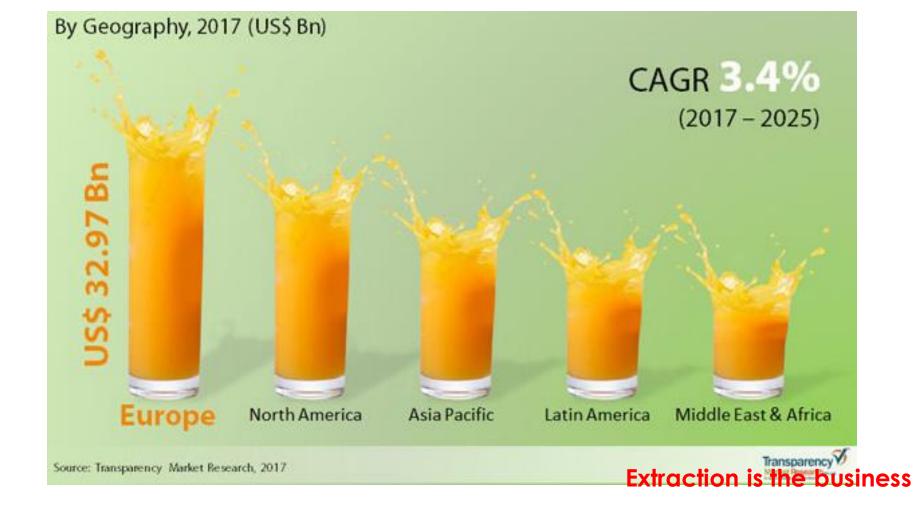


Global Juice Concentrate Market Revenue

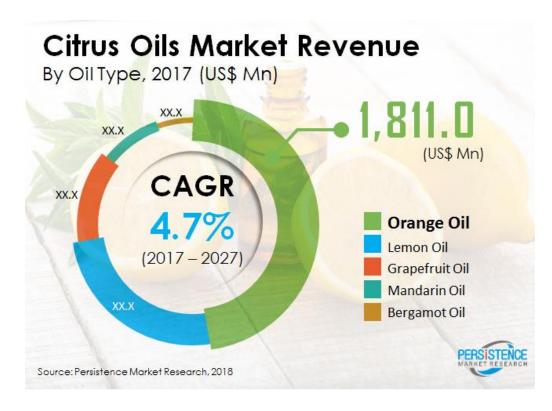






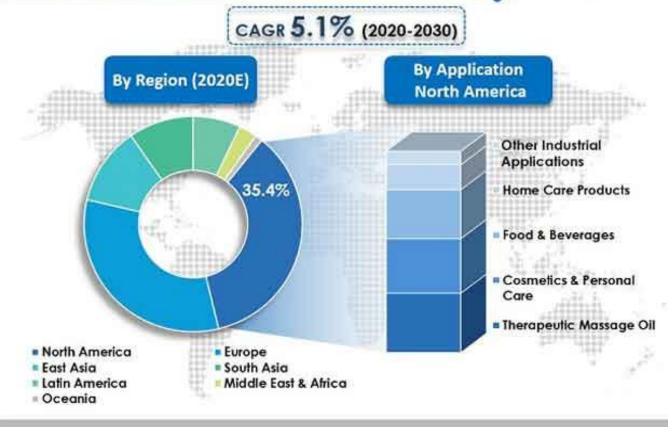


MARKET SHARE ANALYSIS - OIL

- 2025 Extraction Plant to be operational as of January 2025 (i.e. start of production)

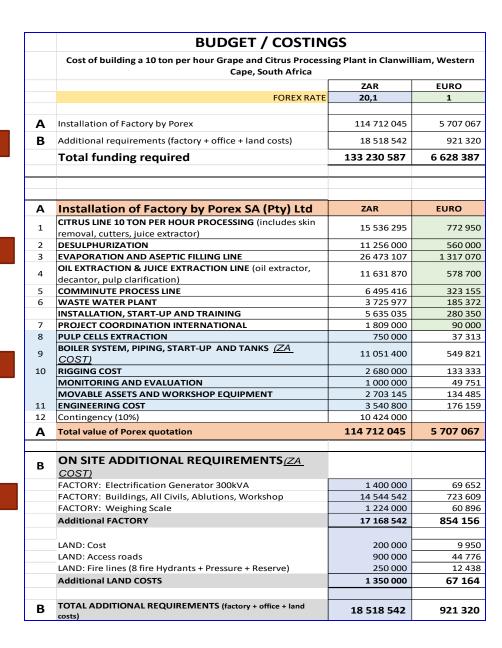

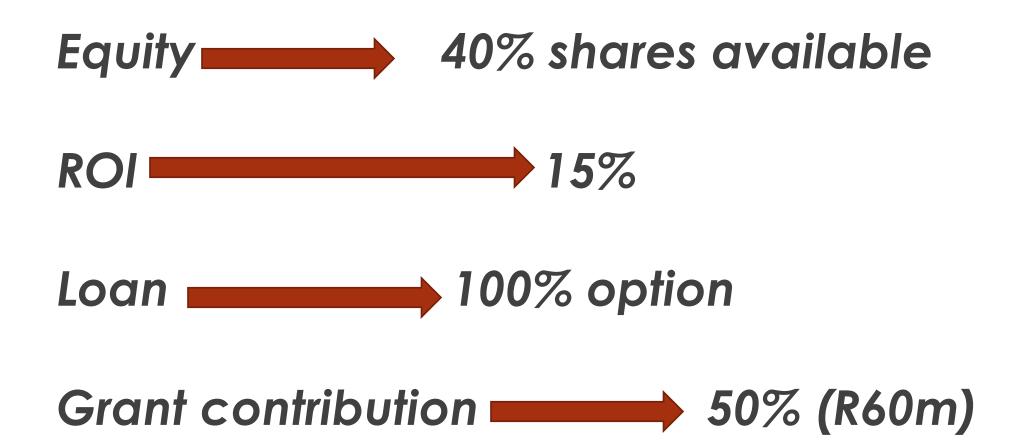
